Caps will be available if need it. Make sure you arrive 15 min. before your session to try caps and be ready to start your session on time. If you are not ready for you session we will ask you to reschedule your appointment, we do not guarantee appointment availability. A reschedule fee of \$15 will apply.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON PHOTO DAY?

You should come prepared for a Professional Style Portrait. Please understand one of your images will be included on your class photo, to be cherished by your classmates, as well as the school, since a copy of your class photo will hang on the school wall for many years.

Ladies, please use appropriate makeup and have your hair styled to avoid strands falling in the wrong places. We do not have time to correct stray hairs and if a correction is requested, there is an additional charge.

Gentlemen should be well groomed. While ties present a more professional image, your class should decide whether they are necessary. Men should be shaven unless you wear a beard.

You will be photographed 2-6 times with a variety of poses. You will view your poses on our computer monitor. You will select the image to be included on the class photo. **You may order from any of the poses**, not just the class photo. Please have your order form complete before your appointment.

For the class photo a proof will be sent to your class representative for your approval. Please make sure we used the correct image and we spelled your name correctly.

If you do not desire a class photo, prices are \$45 for the first unit and \$15 each additional unit. **Please order everything for your needs today**. Prices for reordering will be higher to cover shipping and handling.

How to Look Good in Photos

1. **Focus your eyes** just slightly above the camera lens, move your face forward a bit, and tip down your chin.
2. **Put your tongue behind your teeth and smile**, which will relax your face.
3. **Keep your arm by your side**- but not glued there. To look natural they should be little away from your body.
4. **Test- drive clothing against a white wall**,with an indirect, natural light source (under a tree, indoors near a window) it will show whether blue is really your best color.
5. **As a rule avoid patterns.**
6. **Photos exaggerate everything, so go easy on the makeup.** For women under 30, a little mascara and lip gloss;over 30, add a touch of concealer.
7. **Practice the classic model pose:** turn your body $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way toward the camera, with one foot in front of the other and one shoulder closer to the photographer. When your face forward, your body tends to look wider.
8. **For standing photos**, belly in, buttocks tight, shoulders back, spine straight.
9. **Study phonogenic people** as well as photos in which you think you looked best. Look at your best angle. You will probably see that you were laughing or having a good time. Capturing someone when they are relaxed or most animated usually makes for the best results.
10. **To feel at ease, try closing your eyes**, the opening them slowly just before the photo is taken.
11. **Finally, do not come in front of the camera thinking “ I take terrible photos”.** Your attitude will show up in the image. Be positive and follow these tips.
